- The Education Program is a three-year Basics Program of Al-Ghazzali Centre Academy.
- The Basics Program is for students in the age group of 7-12 years, i.e., they must commence the program within this age group.
- The program follows the yearly school terms.
- The program fees is \$10 per class, \$5 per child thereafter (payable upfront per term).
- The program includes all notes and books to be provided by Al-Ghazzali Centre
- The program includes field trips to the Observatory as well as Australian Heritage facilities.
- A yearly 2-day camp/retreat is a recommended part of the program, and not compulsory.
- The yearly retreat costs are excluded from the Basics Program fees and will notified when applicable.
- Discipline and learning development is essential parts of the program. A lack of it on the student's part will require parent-teacher meetings.
- Parents are welcome to join the classes and field trips, but not retreats.
- Every child who successfully completes the three-year program, will immediately be offered a placement in our Diploma Program on Islamic Sciences.
- Selected students who complete the Basics Program as well as the Diploma Program, will be given a scholarship to study Islam in Jordan or Yemen to further their studies.
- One to three students will be awarded scholarships to learn at the feet of the greatest Scholars of our time.
